Fellowship Changes

Have you ever noticed how your relationship with someone else can have a sudden change for the better? When I see one of the teachers for Wednesday youth, or a table parent, or a driver on a youth event, talking with the children and teens, giving them attention and care, it changes my relationship with that person. I feel more strongly that we're on the same

team, partners in something important. I see them differently-I know more of their heart and feel closer to them.

That's been happening with Libby and me as we make decisions about our new house in Akron. We've never had a house of our own before. In church parsonages, the major decisions are made by the church. Now, it's up to us. As we've been talking and deciding about paint colors, wall tiles, wood for the kitchen cupboards, and all the rest, it's deepened our marriage. I feel closer to her. We've been a team in a new way. I understand her better and know she understands me better.

The house is almost ready, the kitchen nearly finished. We like the new steps in from the garage (and the added space that gives our tiny garage). We're looking forward to the move in June into *our* new house.

Grafton will be the eighth church that we've moved from. It's never easy to say goodbye and make the change. It has been a blessing to be here. Your kindness to us has been special. Seeing your love and care for each other and for this community has strengthened our faith. Being in worship with you is a joyful thing.

We've always found the process of leaving brings us closer to people in the church. Maybe it's looking back and giving thanks. Maybe it's that time is short and we focus on what we have together. Maybe it's that the ending reveals things we had overlooked or taken for granted. Whatever it is, I'm thankful for the closeness that grows in the time of leaving.

Times of leaving always open new things to me in Scripture. This time, it's helped me see more into Paul's heart when he writes to the Philippians. He begins his letter saying, ³ I thank my God every time I remember you. ⁴ In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy ⁵ because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now. ⁶ I am confident of this, that he who began a good work among you will bring it to completion until the day of Jesus Christ. ⁷ It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, because you hold me in your heart, for all of you share in God's grace with me, both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel. ⁸ For God is my witness, how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus. ⁹ And this is my prayer, that your love may abound more and more with knowledge and depth of insight ¹⁰ to help you to discern what is best, so you may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, ¹¹ filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ for the glory and praise of God.

I am glad for May and June, that we might have these weeks to be together in partnership in the good news, to share in worship and the joy of Christ. God bless you,




Comments:
