If you are wondering whether a Bible Study, Meeting or a Sunday Worship Service will be held due to hazardous weather conditions, there are a couple of ways to check:


If during the week, Midview Schools are closed, the Church will be closed also.



On Sunday, check Channel 3 and/or Channel 5 for Closing


