



I miss being out here. Sitting enclosed in the house not being able to hear the birds or see the routine of the people walking by taking the dogs out for a walk, running or just

walking by themselves.

Not being out there in the morning feels like a time of isolation.

That got me thinking about how often we isolate Christ from the rest of the community. When we confine him to the four walls of the church.

After all Christ belongs to the world and not just to us. We need to be looking for ways to take Christ out into the community and not expect the community to come to us.

The angel at the tomb told the women not to fear that Christ had gone ahead of them to Galilee. Many theologians have argued that Galilee referenced in this passage was truly the world, Christ had gone ahead and would meet them in the world.

Agree or not agree with the theologians what was Christ's final commandment to his disciples prior to his ascension?

He commanded them to "Go then to people everywhere and make them my disciples: baptize them in the name of Father, Son and Holy Spirit" (Matthew 28: 19).

"Go", an action word, not "wait" for the seekers to come to us but to seek them out.

We have a rich heritage as United Methodists in being a movement for change in the world. John Wesley, founder of the Methodist movement said "the world is my parish". Let us reclaim the energy producing nature of our denomination by going into the world and not just consuming energy by waiting for the seekers to seek us out.

## WINTER WEATHER Closing Procedure

If you are wondering whether a Bible Study or a Sunday Worship Service will be held due to hazardous weather conditions, there are a couple of ways to check:

#### #1. First and most important: DON'T COME TO CHURCH IF IT'S NOT SAFE.

#### #2. During the week, if schools are closed, then the church is closed.

The office will not be open and we'll not have evening meetings. Pastor Bob will be available by phone. His cell number is 216-544-2441. You can also leave messages on the church answering machine.

#3. For Sundays, as a general rule, the church will be open unless safety personnel ask that no one travel the highways.

If the church is closed, it will be announced on TV Channels 3 and/or Channel 5.


