








The Annual



# UPDATE ON HOW WE ARE "PUTTING GOD'S WORD TO WORK"

Contributions to Smile Train and "Children's Change for Change" continue after the Covid 19 shutdowns.



We collect monies to support Smile Train which is a charitable organization that provides lifesaving surgeries to children who are born with a cleft palate. This condition prevents babies from suckling and they are

unable to thrive for lack of nourishment. Once the surgery is done, the infants have the ability to eat and grow healthy bodies. All surgeries are done by volunteer medical professionals and those trained by certified medical professionals. Families learn about good health practices and the love of Jesus Christ. Anyone may donate to this life-giving mission at any time.



"Children's Change for Change" began many years ago and we are still providing support for a deserving young person in Rwanda. Our congregation sends \$38 per month to provide her with the teach-

ings of Jesus, clothing, food, school supplies, transportation, and other necessities to allow her to attend school. We also send an extra months allowance 2x a year; one for her birthday and one for Christmas. In order to make a change in someone's life, it takes a little "change." Thank you for giving to this mission any time.
